

- Mark with blue dots: Points where the multidisciplinarity of ECGS is made visible and taken into account






OUTCOMES


Portfolio combining all 3 needs: sense of community, identifying & articulating skills, multidisciplinary nature of ECGS

- A free-to-use <u>ECGS Portfolio Moodle area</u>


