Among the topics are: State Succession Revisited (Shaw), Selected Problems of Public International Law (Evensen), The UN Convention on the Law of the Sea and Customary International Law (Soons), Human Rights and Humanitarian Law (Melander), European Integration and Finland (Paasivirta), The Rights of Man and the Rights of the Market-Place (Maude).

The lectures and seminars are given in English. The Summer Seminar will be held at the Porthania Building of the University of Helsinki (lecture hall P II, Hallituskatu 11-13, SF-00100 Helsinki). During the Summer Seminar it is possible to obtain two different kinds of Certificates: i) Certificate of Active Attendance and ii) Certificate of Successful Examination on International Law (The Seminar Diploma).

The Seminar consists of courses and seminars. Diploma candidates are also obliged to participate in the Seminar Examination.

ADMISSION

To obtain admission to the courses, one has to register by filing in a registration form or by sending the application of attendance preferably before August 2, 1993. There is a registration and tuition fee of 300 Fmk or 50 US\$ which should be paid in advance at the time of registration. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are free to make their own arrangements for accommodation. A limited number of rooms has been reserved from the Helsinki Summer Hotels. The rooms can be reserved through the Secretariat of the Summer Seminar. The reservations will be accepted on a continuing basis. The cost for accommodation in double rooms including breakfast will be 135 FIM a day. Private accommodation may also be arranged for some participants. Reasonably priced meals are available at the University restaurants.

There will also be excursions and receptions. Time for recreation and entertainment will be reserved in the course program. The City of Helsinki, the capital of Finland, is situated at the coastline of the most unique and beautiful archipelago-area. The Secretariat gives detailed information to the participants of recreational facilities.
