REMEMBER WHEN INTERPRETING THE HUL 3 -RESULTS

- The data collection process is not yet well-established. HUL 3 has been collected only twice and thus is not as well functioning process than the bachelor HUL's.
- We have been trying to find out the best possible timeframe:
 - In 2021 the invitation to respond to the survey was sent to a large portion of students.
 - In 2022/23 it was decided to focus on students participating a thesis seminar, and unfortunately this collection did not work in all the degree programs due to SISU registrations.
- The response rates are in some programs low and this needs to be kept in mind when interpreting the results. In some programs there were so few participants that the system does not show the results at all.
- We will continue to develop the data collection process further, <u>but also need the help from degree programs to encourage the students to respond to the survey</u>.


