




WHAT IS UNITALENT?




HOW TO APPLY




- Go to the <u>JobTeaser</u> companies page or the UNITalent website where the organizations are listed
- The list will be visible latest 30.10.
- You can log into JobTeaser with your helsinki.fi user id. If you haven't used JobTeaser before, you can find more information on <u>Instructions for students</u>.
- Familiarize yourself well with the dates that have been set by the organization you are interested in. Can you commit to the schedule?
- You can apply to one or two hosts. We recommend choosing two and to prioritize them: which is your first choice and why? We will ask for a short statement of motivation as part of the application.

- The application form includes space for your statement of motivation to join this particular group.
