 - ✓ promote language research and postgraduate studies among universities
 - ✓ create connections between universities, research centres and individual researchers

 - ✓ Langnet welcomes all doctoral researchers, supervisors and other researchers in languagerelated fields to join the network!
- Langnet's operations are financed with...
