Background

Demonstrate the relevance of the research. Describe shortly what research has already been conducted, and how this project contributes to the field. Write a specific research goal and a research question.

Summary of work

Summarize the key aspects and design of your study, participants, context, study procedures and methods. If you use quantitative data, name statistical procedures and tests used. If you use qualitative data, name the research methods used.

Summary of results

Report the key findings of your work in relation to the research question/s.

Discussion

Report shortly the main outcome of the study and link this research with relevant prior research.

Conclusion

Evaluate your project and make suggestions for further research. Deal with So what and Now what questions.

Take-home message

Write in clear and short sentences the most important message/s of the project.

Word Count: Maximum 350 words (structure headings are included in the word count)
