

The discussion forum in Moodle can be, for example:

1. A forum for current announcements from the teacher on the course landing page.

Completing a quiz Learning together Moodle FAQ

- This type of a discussion forum is often named News.
- Only the course teacher can post in this forum.
- You can find this kind of a forum in the Welcome section of this course.
- 2. A shared discussion or Q&A area for the teacher and students.
 - The teacher can, for example, set the forum so that you can see other students' responses in the forum only after you have posted to the forum yourself.
- 3. A platform for assignment submissions and peer review.
 - You can demonstrate your competence in the topics covered during the course through posts and comments.
 - This enables the students to learn from each other by viewing and commenting on other students' posts.
 - In the forum, you can add attachments to new discussion threads or responses.


