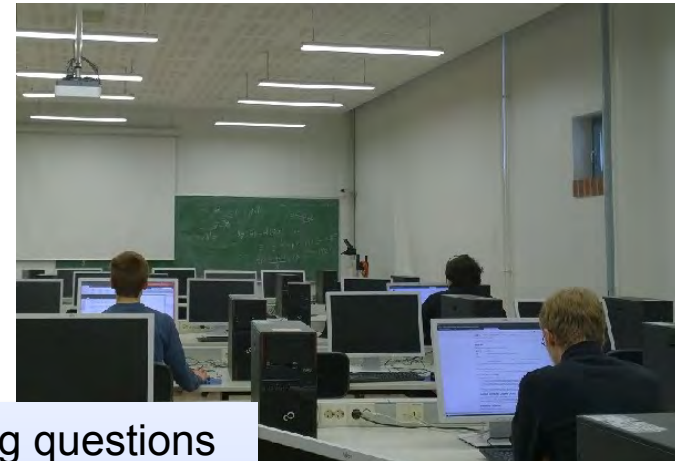

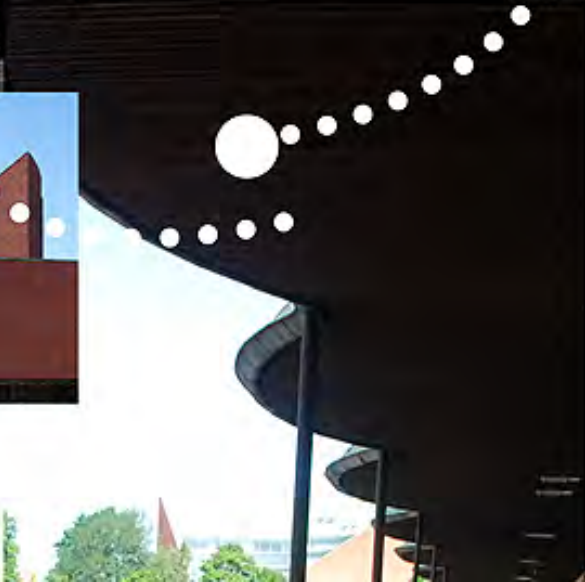


# “Narrative”
