UniPID Mission

The Finnish University Partnership for International Development (UniPID) supports higher education institutions in bringing global responsibility and Global South perspectives into their <u>education</u>, <u>research</u>, and <u>societal impact</u> activities, thus promoting international partnerships in support of sustainable development pathways.

Pillars of higher education

- <u>Education</u>: students can access high-quality courses on sustainable development in collaborative initiatives.
- <u>Research</u>: collaborative projects involving partners and stakeholders in the Global South.
- <u>Societal impact</u>: Universities alongside other research organizations – take part in policy dialogues on sustainable development pathways.

Education: virtual Studies

- 10-20 online courses on global development, Global South and sustainable development
- Open and free of charge for member university students
- All courses are in English and worth 5 ECTS
- Course selection varies from year to year
- Each course is offered at least three times
- Students can also compile a study module, Sustainability in Development, of at least 5 courses (25 ECTS)

Research: UniPID DocNet

- A network established in 2016 with the goal of supporting interdisciplinary training and networking of development research and doctoral researchers based in the UniPID member universities
- Aims to bring together both doctoral researchers and interested supervisors to facilitate peer support and relevant academic contacts, and to exchange information and experiences.

- Eligibility criteria:
 - Enrolled and active doctoral researcher in a UniPID member university
 - Dissertation relates to development research, global development and/or Global South

The most important criteria is that the doctoral researcher finds the network useful!

Societal impact: ethical guidelines for working with the Global South

Context:

- Finland's national initiatives for academic collaboration with the Global South have increased
 - Aim at reciprocal partnerships vs. prevailing Eurocentric discourses and practices, and framework for collaboration
 - Inclusion of academics from the Finnish HEIs, who may not have previous experience cooperating with partners from and in the context of the Global South
- Challenges in the international order and geopolitics:
 - Uncertainties related to academic collaboration with partners from countries with political restrictions and with sanctions

Societal impact: ethical guidelines for working with the Global South

- In Finland, the research community is committed to guidelines by the Finnish National Board on Research Integrity (TENK)
 - In line with international codes of conduct
- Ethics of Global South related research and collaboration not considered as a whole in Finland
- UniPID's initiative to develop complementary guidelines for Global South related academic partnerships, supported by an international steering group
- Two step approach
 - Micro level focus: address everyday challenges and good practices
 - Macro level focus: policy-relevant recommendations for structural change
