Respondeo, dicendum,

quod cogitationes immittere dupliciter potest accipi, scilicet, vel quod angelus illam cogitationem eliciat, vel quod cogitantem excitet per species.

Primo modo est impossibile. Sicut enim visio corporalis dependet a duobus, sic spiritualis. Sicut visio non potest esse a parte videntis sive elicentis nisi a virtute visiva, sic nec cogitatio potest esse nisi a virtute cogitativa, quia si alius faceret, iam non esset nostra² obiective.

facere dupliciter, excitando humores per quos homo convertitur ad cogitandum de hiis ad quae facilius inclinatur, vel offerendo species in fantasia, quibus oblatis necesse est cogitare, sicut dicit Augustinus, *De libero arbitrio III*,³ non est in potestate nostra quibus visis tangamus. Sed bene est in potestate, utrum ibi inmoremur, quia potest voluntas advertere intellectus ab illis speciebus, et tunc non cogitat.
