The Master's School in Russian and East European Studies/Expertise in Russian and Eastern European studies is maintained by the network of twelve Finnish universities. The Master's School is a unique combination of multidisciplinary and cooperation between universities, and it offers a greater course supply to its students than any individual university would be able to offer. In addition to offering courses on Russia and Eastern Europe, the Master's School arranges a Summer School in Russian and East European Studies, organizes seminars backing Master's theses, financially supports inter-university mobility, creates new opportunities for international mobility and for study trips to Russia and to Eastern and Central European countries.

In the Russian and Eastern European Study program a student can specialize in Russian and Eastern European studies. Furthermore student is able to widen her/his knowledge regarding REES area in own study field as well as multidisciplinary. Student will graduate from your own university and faculty.
