Membership fee for spring term 2014

Payment

To enrol at the University of Helsinki for the spring term 2014, you have to pay the Student Union (HYY) membership fee. The obligatory fee includes the health care fee of the Finnish Students Health Service FSHS (YTHS). Note that the FSHS fee is not insurance policy neither does it cover hospitalization costs. The other payments listed below are voluntary.

You can pay your membership fee at the Bank/ATM by using the general reference number 28 04990.

SUMMARY OF THE PAYMENTS (spring 2014)

Student Union membership fee:

Choose option A or B, depending whether you are studying master or doctoral studies. If you have the right to study both master and doctoral studies at the University of Helsinki, the membership fee for Master's degree students is obligatory for you.

A: Students studying for Bachelor's or Master's degree: 45,00 € (obligatory, including the health care fee for FSHS)

B: Doctoral/PhD students: 23,00 € (voluntary, not entitled to use health care services of FSHS)

You can also pay these voluntary payments:Student nation membership fee12,00HYY's development project5,80HYY's Finno-Ugrian programme5,10SYL's development project5,40

Enrolling at the University of Helsinki Automatic enrolment is not in use for the spring term.

Existing students. After paying the Student Union membership fee you have to register for attendance at the Student Services of the University (http://www.helsinki.fi/neuvonta/english/index.htm). Please take the receipt of the payment with you.

Doctoral/PhD students may join the Student Union if they wish. If you have registered for attendance during autumn 2013 without paying the Student Union membership fee, but now wish to join the Student Union for the spring term 2014, you have to pay the membership fee and bring the receipt of payment to the Student Services of the University (see contact details above). However doctoral students are not entitled to use health care services of FSHS (YTHS). If you have he right to study both master and doctoral studies, the membership fee for Master's degree students is obligatory for you.

Note: if you forgot to enrol during the period of registration (1.5.–2.9.2013), please contact the Student Services of the University or your own faculty.

New students. You need to submit the original receipt of the payment to your Faculty at the University of Helsinki with the letter of acceptance. Take a photocopy of the receipt for yourself. You will need the copy, among other things, to access various services at the University of Helsinki.

Voluntary payments

Student nation membership

If you want to join a student nation (osakunta), pay the membership fee. Write the acronym of your student nation into the message field of the payment or onto the receipt of the payment. Remind the student services to enter your student nation as well to the student register when registering at the university. After paying the membership fee, a new nation member (also a student changing her nation membership) must go and enrol at the nation. Please, remember to take the receipt of the payment with you.
